Sanction of the President is hereby accorded for incurring an expenditure not exceeding Rs. 3,94,000/- (Rupees three lakhs ninety four thousand only) in connection with implementation of a joint research project under India-Japan S&T Cooperation entitled "Towards understanding the origin of dark energy, dark matter and inflation" by Prof. M. Sami, Centre for Theoretical Physics, Jamia Millia Islamia, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi collaboration with Mr. Shiinji Tsujikawa, Tokyo University of Science, Tokyo, Japan for a total duration of two years from the date of this Sanction Order.

3. As per the financial terms agreed by both sides, the sending side will pay the international transportation cost and the receiving side would provide the local hospitality of the visiting Scientists under the project. The break-up of the approved expenditure is as indicated below and no re-appropriation shall be allowed under this project.

3. As per MOF instructions, the air travel both domestic and overseas, on official account would now be permissible on airlines other than Air India/Indian airlines also, provided the criteria for selecting the alternative airline for official travel are based on better and more competitive prices being offered by the other airlines. Various incentive schemes and concessional fares offered by Air India/ Indian airlines will also be fully utilized.

4. All project related Visits to be undertaken by the scientists from either side in connection with the implementation of the project shall require prior approval from this Department separately on a case to case basis before any expenditure is incurred in this regard.

5. Sanction of the President is also accorded for the release of Rs. 1,90,000/- (Rupees one lakh ninety thousand only) as initial instalment and the payment of this amount may be made to DDO, DST by means of an account payee demand draft drawn in favour of Registrar, Jamia Millia Islamia, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi. Next installment will be released on receipt of utilisation certificate and audited statement of accounts from the grantee institution.



The expenditure involved shall be met out of the budget head Demand No.83-Department of Science and Technology 3425-Other Scientific Research (Major Head) 60.798 International Cooperation (Minor Head) 12-S&T Cooperation with Other Countries-12.00.31-Grants-in-aid during the current financial year 2009-2010 (Plan).


